


We observed the careful installation and testing and our committee was confident that we had found the right person to bring us a whole new concept of sound system engineering. We have not been disappointed.

We were careful to include on the committee those most opposed to spending money on the sound system. At the conclusion of the inaugural service one of the most outspoken of these turned to me and said "it was worth every penny, this is the first time I have heard the sermon in fifteen years" There have been many such comments over the last nineteen months.

Your "turn key" design requires no operator beyond the "off-on" buttons. This feature has saved many hours of "baby sitting" a sound board or responding to phone calls when a board is thrown out of wack by well meaning but untrained people. Our sanctuary is used by many groups and we have not had a problem with any of them using the sound system.

You provided a "console mode" for additional microphones and the use of subwoofers and floor monitors. We have used it several times for musical programs. The enlarged frequency spectrum and the flexibility of manual controls is appreciated by musicians and audience alike.

Our sincere thanks to you and to your staff, we look forward to many more years of trouble free performance from the system and a continuing association with your firm.
